by night

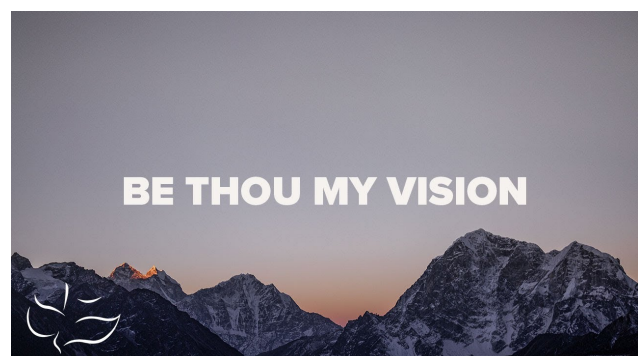
Waking or sleeping, thy presence

**Bible Readings**

**Colossians 3.1-11**

Living as Those Made Alive in Christ

**3** Since, then, you have been raised with  
Christ, set your hearts on things above,  
where Christ is, seated at the right hand of  
God. **2** Set your minds on things above,  
not on earthly things. **3** For you died, and  
your life is now hidden with Christ in God.  
**4** When Christ, who is your a life, appears,  
then you also will appear with him in glory.

**5** Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. **6** Because of these, the wrath of God is coming. [b]  
**7** You used to walk in these ways, in the life you once lived. **8** But now you must also rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. **9** Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices **10** and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator.  
**11** Here there is no Gentile or Jew, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave or free, but Christ is all, and is in all.

##### The Parable of the Rich Fool

**13** Someone in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me."  
**14** Jesus replied, "Man, who appointed me a judge or an arbiter between you?"  
**15** Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; life does not consist in an abundance of possessions."  
**16** And he told them this parable: "The ground of a certain rich man yielded an abundant harvest. **17** He thought to himself, 'What shall I do? I have no place to store my crops.'  
**18** "Then he said, 'This is what I'll do. I will tear down my barns and build bigger ones, and there I will store my surplus grain.  
**19** And I'll say to myself, "You have plenty of grain laid up for many years. Take life easy; eat, drink and be merry."  
**20** "But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?'

**21** "This is how it will be with whoever stores up things for themselves but is not rich toward God."

make us one in Christ, our risen Lord.**

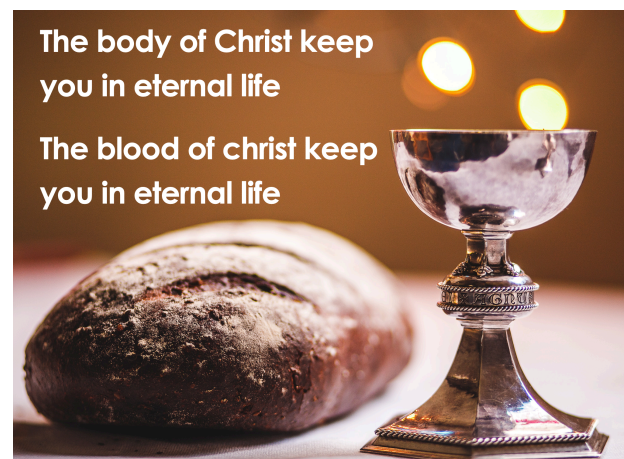
With your whole Church throughout the

of glory.**

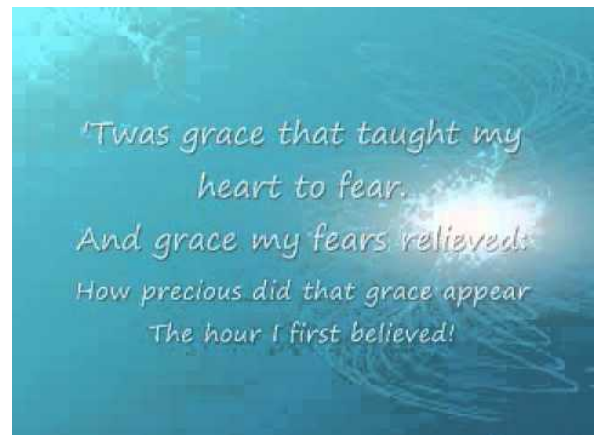
**May we who share Christ's body live
