### **Mark 3.20-35**

#### Jesus Accused by His Family and by Teachers of the Law

**20** Then Jesus entered a house, and again a crowd gathered, so that he and his disciples were not even able to eat. **21** When his family<sup>[a]</sup> heard about this, they went to take charge of him, for they said, “He is out of his mind.”

**22** And the teachers of the law who came down from Jerusalem said, “He is possessed by Beelzebul! By the prince of demons he is driving out demons.”

**23** So Jesus called them over to him and began to speak to them in parables: “How can Satan drive out Satan? **24** If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. **25** If a house is divided against itself, that house cannot stand. **26** And if Satan opposes himself and is divided, he cannot stand; his end has come. **27** In fact, no one can enter a strong man's house without first tying him up. Then he can plunder the strong man's house. **28** Truly I tell you, people can be forgiven all their sins and every

slander they utter, **29** but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will never be forgiven; they are guilty of an eternal sin.”

**30** He said this because they were saying, “He has an impure spirit.”

**31** Then Jesus' mother and brothers arrived. Standing outside, they sent someone in to call him. **32** A crowd was sitting around him, and they told him, “Your mother and brothers are outside looking for you.”

**33** “Who are my mother and my brothers?” he asked.

**34** Then he looked at those seated in a circle around him and said, “Here are my mother and my brothers!

**35** Whoever does God's will is my brother and sister and mother.”



because we all share in one bread.**

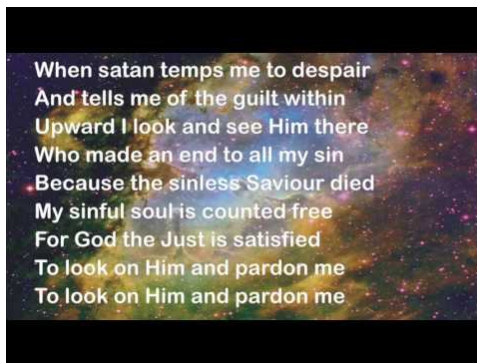
Jesus is the Lamb of God

Amen.**

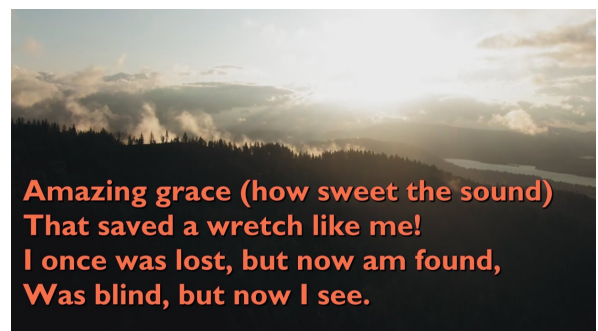
